This Chain of Custody System certification applies to the following:

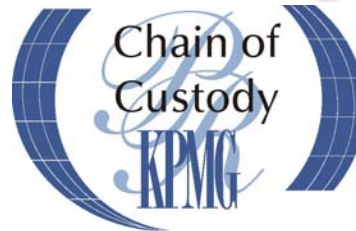
